1. Context of activity/programme at the outset

The problem addressed by the project is corruption that happens during official state inspections in the agrarian sector and food industry and the need to strengthen public participation through NGOs in food safety control system in regions. Another problem addressed by the project is a lack of professional assistance for agrarian and food business for achieving compliance with food safety domestic legislation and international legal norms.

At the outset of project implementation Ukrainian national system of safety and quality of food products has been transforming dynamically with the aim to approach EU legislation. But domestic agrarian and food producers were usually unaware of both requirements of updated national legislation and EU regulations. Thus, activity of food business operators, conditions of production and parameters of food products were not in line with demands of reformed legislation in force. This situation provoked corruption during official inspections – being unaware of modern demands of legislation and state inspections rules business used to bribe inspectors.

To contribute to solving this problem we proposed:

- to develop educative materials on current situation with legislative demands on food safety, reformed system of state control, norms of EU legislation and international treaties signed by Ukraine,
- to establish a number of regional contact points and partners (NGOs and specialists) for communication with local agrarian and food business on food safety and state control issues,
- to prepare a number of trainers (local activists, NGO's representatives, high school teachers and students) for delivering education and consultation to business entities on issues of reformed state control system and international demands for food safety;

- to develop a number of instruments for supporting professional networking and communication among trainers, business and state officials on issues of fair production of food products, food safety and approaching international markets.

2. General objectives; target group

The purpose of the project is to strengthen the position of NGOs in regions of Ukraine as participants of food safety system reforming aimed to strengthen the rule of law and to combat corruption.

Final goals of the project are:

- to contribute to combat corruption due to raising awareness of agro and food business operators on reformed state control system, domestic legislation and international norms for food safety;
- to build a network of trainers/supervisors and public organizations delivering education and assisting food business operators in implementing requirements of national legislation, EU regulatory framework, international standards and best practices;
- to contribute to meet requirements of national and European legislation, international standards and best practices by agro and food business operators;
- to launch communication of profile civil organizations with state officials in Kyiv and regions on issues of safety and quality of food products.

The target groups of the project are: food producers, sectoral agro and food associations in Kyiv and regions, other profile NGOs in regions, officials of the Departments of Agro-Industrial Development (AIDD) of oblast state administrations, officials of the State Service of Ukraine on Food Safety and Consumer Protection (SFCS) and its regional divisions.

- strategic session for enterprises aimed to analyze experience and results of official audit, identify possibilities for further development of processes and products complying with national legislation, EU regulatory framework, international standards;
- development of supervision system for sustainable development of enterprises on the basis of national law, EU regulatory framework, international standards;
- spreading of information in regional media about project activities and results;
- enacting regional segments of the system for professional communication of trainers and supervisors formed under the framework of the project;
- spreading of information on aims and tasks of the "Declaration Portal", filling it with information from enterprises in the agrarian sector and the food industry of the region.

<u>Further information if different to planned activities or problems identified:</u>

Initial stage:

- as far as materials for educative events were developed in electronic form initially (see attachments

here and here) and educative programs were adapted to distant mode due to COVID19 quarantine and

educative materials were included in programs of educative events directly (for T2T training, for T2B

training, for SS2B session), the need to publish educative materials was postponed to the final stage of

the project and then while the page 'Library' of the trainer's network www.kdk.net.ua had been

developed, necessity in hard copies died out;

- it appeared just at first stages of project implementation and was confirmed completely during the next

communication that the idea to create a Declaration Portal is not popular among business operators.

They signalled that it is not possible to implement a huge number of legal demands in full scale thus

declaration on partial compliance would lead to additional attention from corrupted state officials. At

initial state it was proposed to postpone development of the Declaration Portal closer to the end of the

Main stage but then it appeared reasonable to replace the Declaration Portal completely and develop

possibility to declare fairness under the frame of fair producer's cluster (FairFood-Ukraine,

www.ffu.net.ua);

- development of the WEB-page of the project was not planned initially, but it had been developed at

the initial stage and used widely during project implementation.

Activity in regions:

- as far as COVID-19 quarantine made trips to regions impossible only two first trainings for key audiences (for representatives of regional trade chambers and heads of business associations) had been organised in Kyiv and next activity was shifted into virtual space and 'consecutive' work in regions was replaced by 'parallel' simultaneous participating of all target audiences (professionals from NGOs and high schools, representatives of business) for all types of public events (training for trainers T2T, training for business T2B, strategic sessions aimed to meet international demands SS2B);
- some trips to regions with the aim to meet with local trainer's communities had been planning till the summer 2021, but it appeared effective to hold meetings with trainer's community distantly as well;
- development of the national-wide professional trainer's network was not planned initially (only trainer's communities in 12 regions), but <u>accepting knowledges on modern networking</u> from AMD consulting company (The Netherlands) got possible <u>to create trainer's professional network KDK</u> (Компетентність долає корупцію);
- development of distant instruments aimed to support the trainer's activity was not planned initially as well, but shifting activity into the Internet and fast development of IT skills among project participants permitted the development of the IT instrument for trainer's community www.kdk.net.ua.
- in turn, development of a national-wide professional trainer's network and its IT support at www.kdk.net.ua were followed by development of basic documents and registers aimed to activate training and consulting markets in Ukraine and its regions.
- as well, moratorium to state control caused by COVID-19 quarantine influenced much of the key idea of the project on involvement of business into training on the eve of state control events we were looking for other 'hot point' and implementation of HACCP appeared to be the right choice. Training programs, first of all of local trainers, were adapted to this situation and <u>additional analytic note</u> on what are differences in EU and Ukrainian demands for HACCP was created and presented;
- initial plans suggested involvement of regional coordinators, but it appeared that distant coordination from one centre is more effective and activity of regional coordinators was replaced by <u>activity of trainers in regions that trained local business</u> with financial support from the project;
- to be sure of effectiveness of training for trainers we proposed to participants of T2T training to fulfill some 'home work' (it was <u>included in the T2T program</u>) and then get certificates it was not planned initially but by now we have 81 approved trainers;

Final stage:

- filling of the "Declaration Portal" with information from enterprises and spreading of information on tasks and functions of the "Declaration Portal" in central mass media and final press conference was substituted for inviting business to join cluster 'FairFood-Ukraine' www.ffu.net.ua by signing the memorandum (it better matches legislation on personal information), presenting cluster of fair business

<u>operators</u> distantly and <u>posting video</u> at the YouTube channel of Ukrainian Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

Actual implementation period:

The contract suggests the implementation period from 01 October 2019 to 31 May 2021.

Further information if different to planned implementation period:

The start of the project was defined in the contract as October, 01, 2019. But the contract was signed finally only on October 16, 2019. So, the real project implementation period was supposed to be from October 20, 2019 to May 31, 2021, with an interim reporting period – from October 20, 2019 to April 20, 2020. But the economy of project costs caused by COVID-19 quarantine permitted prolonging the project activities till August 31, 2021.

environment for communication among trainers' groups and profile communities;

- the goal to attract public attention to the issues of food safety, combating corruption and meeting demands of EU-UA agreement, to bring trainers' and food business operators' communities together was contributed with the next events that are additional to the frame of the project:

World Food Safety Day 2021 (with presenting awards to certified trainers);

International Anti-Corruption Day;

KDK network constituent assembly;

World Food Safety Day 2022 (with presenting the tool www.kdk.net.ua);

6. Have the overall goals been achieved?

Three short-term goals identified at the start of the project 1) to create a network of public organizations participating in reforming of the food products safety and quality system in the regions, 2) to build a network of trainers/supervisors capable to deliver education and facilitate efforts of the enterprises to put production processes and characteristics of products in a line with the requirements of legislation in force, EU regulatory framework and international standards, 3) to launch communication of civic organizations with public administration authorities in the regions on issues of safety and quality of food products have been achieved.

The medium- and long-term goals of reducing corruption during state inspections of agricultural and food enterprises, sustainable transition to situation while agricultural and food producers are meeting requirements of national and European legislation, international standards and best practices are contributed by establishing of trainers' community and equipping it with a tool for professional communication www.kdk.net.ua and enabling fair food business operators to implement domestic and international rules in effective way under the frame of the FairFood-Ukraine cluster www.ffu.net.ua.

Has the target group been reached?

Initial plans for reaching the target groups had been exceeded for food producers (the plan is 12 regions and 240 enterprises, real involvement is 21 regions and 2 893 business entities), sectoral agro and food associations (planning number is 15, number of real participants – 20), NGOs in regions (the plan is 48 organizations, number of actual participants including regional trade chambers is 54). At the same time the number of regions where local state officials were reached was 7 instead of 12 as it was planned. It is the result of imposing moratorium for state control events during COVID19 quarantine and losing interest from SME business to communicate with local state officials on the state control issues.

Conclusions as regards the skills of the implementing body:

The project team is composed of professionals: coordinator on education Serhiy Shcherbyna is Fulbright program alumni, coordinator on business Pavlo Koval and coordinator of the project Larisa Starikova lead well-known profile agrarian NGOs and are known personally as high level specialists in Ukraine, coordinator on regions Lyubov Nestyrenko is professional manager and communicator, adviser to the head of the Trade Chamber of Ukraine and an elected member of Expert-Consultation Council at State Regulatory Service. High professional level of trainers and organisation of events is marked by participants of training events.

The project team has been paying attention to improving their professional skills. At the initial stage the project team participated in workshop on good regulatory practices of USDA and Bridges program. Larisa Starikova and Serhiy Scherbyna participated in trainings of the Institute of European Politic (Berlin) on modern training skills (please see here, here and here) and development of professional networks (please see info here and here). Larisa Starikova and Pavlo Koval here and here). Larisa Starikova and Pavlo Koval here and here and here and here) and then implemented gained knowledge into educational materials for trainers and business. Project team was oriented toward accepting knowledge and information from partner organizations and projects. Communication with key specialist of the MDF consulting company Sam Boering and Prof. Dr Hub Lelieveld, the President of Global Harmonization Initiative, participation in the presentation 'Main credit for agrarian sector of Ukraine from European Investment Bank', high level expert consultations on human rights in business contributed to sustainability of project results. Participation in the workshop on using of the 'Manual for Entrepreneurs' developed by USAID Competitive Economy Program, in the webinar of EU ASKFOOD alliance 'A cross-disciplinary perspective to promote a sustainable food system', in the webinars 'Food Safety Standards' and 'US Food Safety Regulations' of Penn State Department of Food Science, in the workshop 'From farm to Fork' of the Institute of European Politic,

in meeting with EU ambassadors on the Green Deal context had contributed to knowledge and skills of the team members.

Finally, in September 2021, three members of trainer's network KDK Olexandr Homan (Sumy), Nadyia Boyko (Zakarpattya) and Larisa Starikova (Kyiv) were certified as the ambassadors of the Global Harmonization Initiative (GHI) and experts of the Global Incident Alert Network of GHI.

Further comments on the above conclusions:

COVID19 quarantine influenced not only project activities schedule but the whole concept of the project. At the same time, the project goal to strengthen the position of NGOs in regions of Ukraine as participants of food safety system reforming aimed to strengthen the rule of law and to combat corruption remained fixed. The main impacts of the quarantine are: shifting project training activity into virtual space, banishing hardcopies for educative and information materials, refusing of trips to regions and arranging off-line press-conferences, losing interest of business to get trainings on the eve of regular state control events and shifting it to HACCP issues that has appeared subjected to irregular state control, diminishing the interest to build communication with local state control units at the permanent base and at the institutional level.

Strong sides of COVID19 quarantine are easier involvement of participants and work with regions in distant mode that permitted to overcome initial project's goals essentially, raising effectiveness of communication due to shifting into virtual space, fast development of skills of the project team and project participants for distant communication, accepting of modern IT tools and it using for achieving the project goal to establish communities of trainers and fair food business. Suggestions for the future/lessons learned:

- <u>legal environment</u>: Legislation for official state control and state food control has been harmonized during 2016-2019 in general. But the sphere of normative acts issued by state agencies has remained unreformed (the most remarkable example is the order of Ministry of Agrarian Policy and Food N 590 of October 1, 2012 on HACCP implementation). In fact, deepening of euro integration process in food safety sphere was stopped after the law <u>'On state control on compliance with the law on food, feed, products of animal origin and animal welfare'</u> had been passed. Moreover, right now state agencies are trying to turn the process of harmonization back, implementing principles and basic norms for the state control that are not in line with European ones (draft new version of the state control N 5837 of August 5, 2021 has been submitted to the parliament by The Cabinet of Ministers).

We were trying to explain that discrepancies in EU and Ukrainian legislation for state control create additional barriers for Ukrainian export (last attempt had been done at a meeting of the Committee on Eurointegration of Verkhovna Rada of Ukraine on October 12, 2021). But we are not sure that to be heard. Even the strong position of the project team at EU-UA association official public bodies (Pavlo Koval is the member of Advisory Group, Larisa Starikova – of Ukrainian Side of the Civil Society Platform) does not permit to achieve the positive result as well. So, support and help on behalf of the Netherlands Embassy, the Delegation of the European Union to Ukraine and other European partners aimed to deep harmonized of EU-UA legislation and spread it to the area of the state agencies acts would be in place;

- non-governmental control: Development of arbitrary control on food safety is the cardinal way to combat corruption. By now, the sphere of voluntary certification according to international standards and good practices is well developed within world food markets but is full of problems in Ukraine. National certification system sticks to the state orbit and has not been reformed in an eligible way since the beginning of the 1990s. We tried to make contribution to development of the non-governmental compliance indication system in Ukraine including this issue into training programs for all formats (training to trainers T2T, training to business T2B, strategic session for business SS2B). As well, we arranged a strong partnership with the German AgriTrade Ukraine project and its experts, who identified the problem of lacking quality infrastructure in Ukraine as the biggest obstacle for development of food export.

But now our project is over, AgriTrade project is finishing as well. And we do not know of any other players or efforts to develop the arbitrary system of market compliance in the food industry. So, a situation with further development of arbitrary control in Ukraine looks unsustainable. From the perspective of combating corruption according to the UN Sustainable Development Goal 16.5, implementation of DCFTA the issue of development of arbitrary compliance approving system looks as a priority that needs more attention from the Netherlands Embassy, the Delegation of the European Union to Ukraine and other donors. By now this issue is not possible to solve on behalf of Ukrainian internal resources;

- trainers' community: From the very beginning of the composing trainers' community, we were trying to develop the true free market of training and consulting on food safety control issues in Ukraine. Right now, such a market exists rather in an informal form that does not guarantee the quality of service. At the same time, the market segment of trainings available from the state officials is unreasonably large. Moreover, the state officials try to withdraw freelanced trainers and independent training companies from the market at all.

At the face of such a situation development of trainers' community and empowering it with the practical tools like possibility to establish permanent and temporary units for cooperation, possibility to arrange partnership for development of products and projects, to defend rights for intellectual property, to

concentrate communication in different social networks in one place, to manifest the level of knowledge and skills looks as a strong answer. The IT tool www.kdk.net.ua aimed to support activities of trainers and the trainers' community multiplies the efforts to develop training and consultation markets in all parts of Ukraine and stimulates synergy.

The project has contributed to enlarging the number of agents of changes and participants in reforming and eligible functioning of the food safety system in the regions of Ukraine. Development of financial and economic mechanisms for training and consulting activity gives the background for steady development of food operators introducing modern requirements for food products and processes. At the same time, the capacity of the training's market right now is not sufficient for financing trainers' network KDK headquarter and current support of the communication tool www.kdk.net.ua. The project with donor's support aimed to develop a free market of training, internal financial mechanisms for the trainers' professional network KDK and the tool www.kdk.net.ua is of great need. It is a factor of stability of the food sphere reforming on a larger scale.

- fair business community. As it was mentioned above, combating corruption is the most effective through the development of a non-governmental system for the approval of compliance with the law in force, national and international standards and good practices. The ways of doing fair business are: getting information at training, receiving consultation from specialists at the spot, acquainting with international non-governmental rules and systems, obtaining audits from independent certification bodies. And all these is possible only if supplemented with investments for modernisation of assets and spreading information on how to find information on modern demands, propositions on training, consultation and audit, financial services.

We have made an attempt to put together instruments to meet all these needs under the frame of the cluster of fair food operators FairFood-Ukraine and the tool for its distant support www.ffu.net.ua. As well, cluster conjunction multiplies the efforts to strengthen the community of fair food business and stimulates synergy for development of eligible food products and modern food market, the market of training, information and financial services.

Right now, fair business in Ukraine is in a weak position in comparison with unfair one. And to foster development of the fair business community, to bring the cluster FairFood-Ukraine alive, including its training and consultation segment, by means of donors' support and especially attracting funds for business from European Investment Bank under the frame of Agri-Food Value Chain Project would be of great help for Ukraine.
